NYC spends billions on private contractors for 90% of school busing. Yet, there are shortages of drivers, attendants, paraprofessionals, and nurses, all discouraged by downgraded wages and benefits. We are sick of the DOE’s weak communication; the hot, late, and no-show buses; long rides; and outdated vehicles. We will petition for a ‘School Bus Bill of Rights’ to empower a panel of parents/caregivers, disability advocates, educators, and bus workers over pupil transportation policy decisions.
